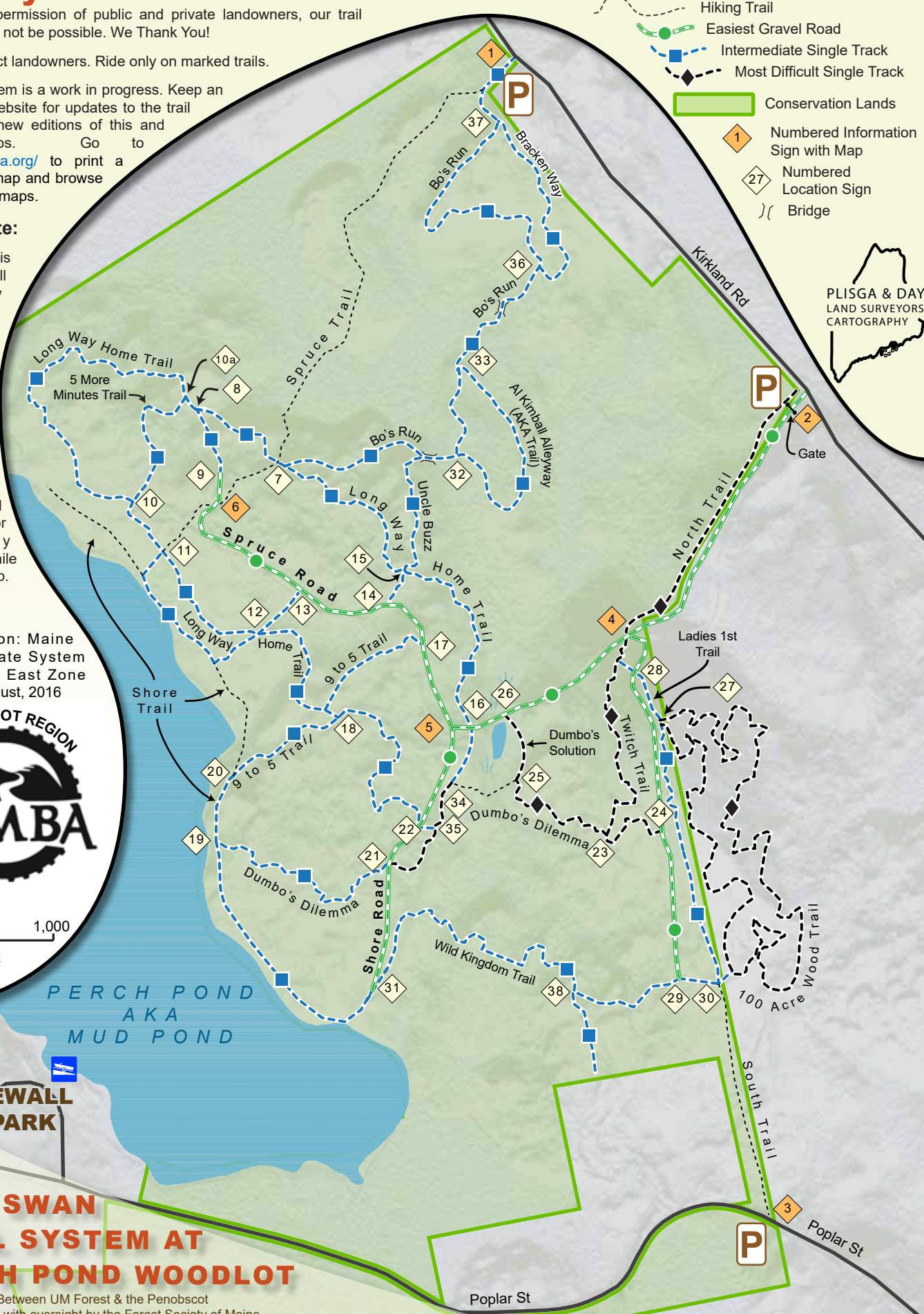
Projection: Maine Coordinate System of 1983, East Zone
